Purge on Plastics

A ‘Purge on Plastics’ motion was approved which included the following:

The council commits itself to reduce the reliance of Single – Use plastics across the District

Working towards the removal of all consumer single use plastics in our workplace.

That the council will work positively with residents and businesses in our area to promote our ‘Purge on Plastics’.

Community Governance Review

The draft proposals of the community governance review were approved to be published for consultation which included the following in Haddenham:

- 1) To move the parish boundary between Wentworth and Witchford for those electors who live on the evens side of Sutton Road Witchford and vote in Wentworth and move them back into the Witchford parish, as shown as Area 6 on the map [added for the sake of clarity].
- 2) To move the parish boundary between Wentworth and Witchford to include the land between Marrow Way lane Witchford and the A142 into Witchford parish.

The recommendation of the working party of a preferred partner was approved and this would now be moved forward to conclusion with a proposal that was hoped would have a very positive outcome for the Mepal outdoor centre and east Cambridgeshire council
